What is Awana? Awana is a Bible club for children. The name Awana is an acronym for "Approved Workmen Are Not Ashamed" from 2 Timothy 2:15. The Awana program includes Bible lessons and memorization, singing and team games and activities. Through the Awana Clubs children are motivated to participate with their team, complete their handbooks, and memorize Scripture through individual and team awards.

Awana Club Participation Definition:

Sparks - Children who will be at least 5 years old by September 1st and are in kindergarten, first or second grade this year.

Truth & Training (T&T) - Children who will be at least 8 years old by September 1st and are in third, fourth, or fifth grade this year.

Trek 24/7 (referred to as Trek) - Children who will be at least 11 years old by September 1st and are in sixth, seventh or eighth grade this year.

Club Time:

Club time will be the same as last year. Every Sunday night all clubbers will start check in at 5:45 p.m. We would appreciate parents not dropping their children off any earlier than this, as there may not be anyone to supervise them until club time. We are usually finished by 7:45 p.m. - please understand if there is a special event we may go a little late.

Registration Form/Activity Permit and Discipline Agreement(green page):

Please be sure to fill out both sides of this form completely and sign it. In the column labeled "Club & Rank" please fill in which of the three Awana clubs each child will be participating in:

Sparks, T&T, or Trek. Rank is equivalent to the handbook that the child will be working in. For example, a child in the 2nd handbook is considered 2nd rank. A child in their 2nd year of club but working in the 1st book is still considered 1st rank. Please be sure to complete the Club Guidelines and Discipline Agreement on the back of this form.

Dues & Supplies (yellow page):

Dues are collected in Awana to help pay for the awards and other supplies. This year we are again going to do advance annual payment with a multiple child discount, and no weekly dues. Dues will be charged as follows: \$15.00 for one child, \$25.00 for two children and \$30.00 for three or more children per family. Checks should be made payable to "FHCC Kid's Club". If the cost of Awana supplies (handbooks, uniforms, etc.) will prohibit your child(ren) from attending club, please talk to Pastor Jim Bartsch about your situation. There are scholarships available for special situations.

Handbooks and Uniforms (yellow page):

Each clubber needs a handbook and uniform to participate. All children start with the first rank handbook regardless of their age. They do not move on to book two until book one is completed. All Trek students order the current year's bible study book.

The following information should be helpful in determining which size uniform to order. If the uniform does not fit when it arrives, return it unworn in the original package to Haley Peters (273-6699) to exchange for the correct size. If your child is in the same club as last year, and his/her uniform still fits, there is no need to purchase a new one. Or if a younger child can wear an older sibling's previous uniform - great! We currently do not have an organized system for returning and/or purchasing used uniforms. However, if you are interested in selling or buying a used uniform, let Haley know, and she'll put you in touch with any others who have shown interest.

Sparks Vests - 65% polyester/35% cotton

(For chest size, have child stand with arms down at his/her sides, and measure all the way around chest and arms.)

Small (6)	- chest size 28"
Medium (8)	- chest size 30"
Large (10)	- chest size 34"
X-large (12)	- chest size 37"
XX-large (14)	- chest size 38"
XXX-large (16)	- chest size 43"

T&T T-Shirts - 100% pre-shrunk cotton

(For chest size, have child stand with arms down at his/her sides, and measure across front of chest, including arms, 1" below the armhole.)

Youth size 10	- chest size 15.5"
Youth size 12	- chest size 16"
Youth size 14	- chest size 17.5"
Youth size 16	- chest size 19"
Adult Small	- chest size 19"
Adult Medium	- chest size 21"
Adult Large	- chest size 23"
Adult X-Large	- chest size 25"
